




Traditional vs. Medicare Advantage



Fitting the Product

Can the OTC pre-sets get close to NAL-NL2 targets?

- Some anecdotal data suggests we can get close but large errors exist.
- Concern is that users will assume that OTC's do not work and give up rather than trying another device or another program.





The Size of the OTC Market

Estimates of the OTC market range from 100,000 to one million units.


No organization is tracking sales, so it is difficult to get accurate numbers.



The OTC Buyer



- Is younger
- Wants a simple process (no appointment or prescription)
- Probably is a situational user (dinner, meetings, social environments)
- Inclined to purchase from a brand they recognize



Considerations for OTC - 2022



Will the success of OTC devices depend on traditional manufacturers partnering with existing consumer brands?

Will new entrants gravitate to the OTC category to avoid lengthy FDA submissions required for self-fitting devices?

Will affordability be achieved by new OTC devices, or will they compete with entry-level prescription devices?

Can self-fitting devices change the stigma around hearing aids by directly engaging the consumer?

Very cheap devices exist, however those that give similar benefit to RX devices have comparable pricing

Several new form factors – earbuds, eyeglasses may change this
